## Fact Sheet for International Delegations

### General Information

The conference will be held between the Vitória Convention Center and Universidade Federal do Espírito Santo (UFES) campus from September 26-29th 2018.

### Hotels

There are two recommended hotels in Vitória: The Sheraton Vitória and The Golden Tulip Vitória. Both are within walking distance of the Convention Center. Room rates vary but are usually below \$90 USD per night.

### Flights

If you are flying in to Vitória from outside of Brazil, it is best to connect via Rio de Janeiro (GIG) or São Paulo (GRU). Domestic flights to Vitória (VIX) are available from these airports via Azul Airlines, Avianca, and LATAM Brazil. These flights are roundtrip, operate daily, and cost approximately \$100 USD on average.

### Cost and Coordination

Individuals presenting at the conference are welcome at \$400 per person. International delegations are welcome to bring as large a group as they wish. The first ten delegates share a banded cost of \$4,000 USD, and each additional delegate will cost \$400. The delegation rate includes (1) a plenary panel or workshop within the conference, (2) pre- and post-conference tour rates and (3) invitation to a delegation reception event. Due to the size of the conference, delegations will be responsible for their own flights, accommodations, and local transportation around Vitória.
